Thank you much for the input.

I tested for Java, and found none! I think in the process of 'reinstalling' IE, the new version did not include JVM due to the ongoing Sun/MS crap.

So I installed Sun's Java, and all worked great. Until...

I turned on AdSubtract again (I had shut it down for the install). So with AdSubtract off, CNN and ESPN load and seem to do fine. But with it back on, I get weirdness:

The same symptoms as before.

When I try to run the Java Tester, which worked after I installed Sun Java, IE 6 just completely closes. No crash, just closes.

Appreciate further info. Do I need to reconfigure a proxy, or something similar.
