> IE will no longer load my website [www.jerseyspeedskiffs.com](http://www.jerseyspeedskiffs.com) when trying to connect via my Comcast broadband connection. None of the individual pages from my site will load either. My website host's home pages originate from the same place and load with no problem as do all other websites I've gone to. My host is westlin.com and they inform me they have not had any problems with their equipment and their Apache server has not had any down time. I've run a ping on DOS as well as a tracert and everything looks good there.

(63ms average time for ping return and 16 hops on the trace route with no discernible lags there) I've also done all the usual stuff such as clearing cache & history, deleting cookies, run PestPatrol, restarted, etc., more than a couple of times with no improvements. Since I use my website as my home page, I tried changing my homepage and typing my website into the address bar, but that doesn't work either. I've tried running the repair on IE and received no notice of any problem there. I've also run Configsafe and went back two days before I started experiencing a problem.

> I can however get my site to come up without any problems and fully navigate it if I use AOL. I believe the AOL connection still must run through Comcast to a point and I think the AOL still runs through IE so I'm totally lost as to why IE alone will no longer load just my website. Since I could access my site via AOL, I went into the sites control panel to check if there were any IP addresses on the ban IP address list and there were none as there should not have been any anyway. The reason I did this was to see if maybe someone had hacked my site and put my IP address in the ban list or something but everything appeared normal. Since Comcast uses a constant IP address verses AOL's variable IP address this seemed like a valid reason to check.
