> I scrolled through some of the messages and came across one
> from Don Varnau that discussed how to download IE. So I
> went to <http://www.broomeman.com/support/wsiedown.html> and
> downloaded ie6setup.exe from there. I then followed the
> site's instructions in Step 3, 4, 5, and 6.

>
> I got a message that the file is downloaded in
> c:\winnt\Windows Update Setup Files. When I went there I
> did not find any ie6setup.exe file.

>
> So I just went back to c:\downloads and double-clicked on
> ie6setup.exe.

> I installed Internet Explorer; however, the shortcut on
> the Desktop that it installed does not work. It also did
> not install Internet Explorer shortcut in the tray. Nor
> did it install Outlook Express in the tray. What I have in
> the tray is a blank square that says Launch Internet
> Explorer Browser when I place my cursor over it.

> When I double click on the blank square, it says it is
> searching for something (I forget exactly what it says) but
> does not launch the browser.

> Can someone offer me some advice on how I can fix this
> problem.
