>with spyware and adware software. This has changed the
>toolbar and links on my IE browser and it's causing a lot
>of popup ads to appear when I surf the Internet. At one
>time it was even causing keyword searches in the IE
>browser to be diverted to a little-known search engine,
>too.

>I utilized the Aluria Spyware Eliminator software and it
>removed a number of spyware files, but my Internet
>Explorer browser is still not back to normal.

>I tried uninstalling Internet Explorer through the
>Add/Remove Software feature in Windows XP, but despite
>the fact that IE no longer appeared in that program
>window, I was still able to browse with IE 6. I've since
>reinstalled IE 6 through the Microsoft Web site also, but
>the IE program still does not appear in the Add/Remove
>Software window.
