> Yesterday I installed ungraded AOL to verision 9.0. Once
> I Install 9.0, IE would not open up and fill entire
> screen. It would leave a one inch gap from the top of
> the window to the top of the screen, where I could see my
> desktop. I nothing i did or the aol tech did could fix
> the problem. I refreshed the desktop. I tried dragging
> the taskbar to top and screen and back down again. I
> rebotted the computer several times. Finally I
> uninstalled 9.0 and had to run a windows XP restore to
> fix the problem. Anyone ever have this problem and know
> how to fix?
