- > *4. Disable both Zone Alarm and Norton Antivirus*

- > *In Explorer under security setting I have "Download signed ActiveX controls)*
- > *Enable and "Script ActiveX controls*
- > *marked safe for scripting" Enabled, but at certain sites I get a message*
- > *that the page will not load because*
- > *these settings are Disabled and need to be changed.*

- > *Also I just tried to post this question on the web based viewer but could*
- > *not because of pop-up blocker. Checked internet*
- > *options under privacy and the pop-up box isn't check. Looks like any*

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- > *changes I make to Explorer are not taking effect.*
