- > *few of the buttons or images. I can sometimes get the page to load correctly*
- > *by hitting refresh a few times. This problem doesn't seem to be specific to*
- > *any webpage in particular.*
- > *I didn't have this problem before SP2. I had Windows XP Pro SP1*
- > *working fine. There was no spyware when I searched my system with AdAware,*
- > *SpyBot, and CWShredder. Virus scans didn't detect anything either. Just to*
- > *be safe, I formatted my hard drive and did a clean install of Windows XP Pro*
- > *and then upgraded to SP2 without going to any websites. I encountered the*
- > *same problem. I tried installing Firefox, but I'm getting the same problem.*
- > *This problem doesn't seem to affect anything else, as I am able to download*
- > *e-mail messages while I'm experiencing the problem. I think I already know*
- > *the answer is to uninstall SP2 and go back to SP1, but I'd like to stay with*
- > *SP2 if at all possible. Thanks in advance for the help.*
