Hi,

Try these easy steps first. You might get lucky. ;-))

First, clear the IE cache. IE> Tools> Internet Options> General> Delete files (and delete offline content.) It's often recommended that the TIF folder be kept at about 50 MB (Settings.)

Then find the Cookies folder(s) and delete any cookies from hotmail, msn or passport. Or delete all cookies.

Check that settings aren't too restrictive in Internet Options> Privacy (Cookies)
