>>> message in the IE status bar and then I see an Error on page message.  
I  
>> can  
>>> click on the symbol in the status bar (yellow triangle with exclamation  
>>> mark) and see the script error information. Some of these links that I  
>>> can't access on my computer can be accessed on another computer, so I  
am  
>>> trying to figure out if something is missing or corrupted on my  
machine.

>>> I have looked at the Microsoft page on How to Troubleshoot Script  
Errors:  
>>> <http://support.microsoft.com/kb/308260>  
>>> and have tried the suggestions up to repairing the script engine, but  
>> since  
>>> I am already running Windows XP, it looks like I would have to try and  
>>> repair XP. I was hoping I would be able to do something that wouldn't  
>>> involve me having to reinstall SP2 on a dial-up modem (hours and hours  
>>> and  
>>> hours to download all of the updates, etc.).

>>> I have checked firewalls, antivirus, etc.
