For some reason, all of my http downloads are hanging; for example, anything from ZDNet or free software from third parties. They all start fine, and go half or even two thirds before simply stalling out. I have Norton Internet Security and the XP firewall on. To date, these have never been a problem. Any ideas? Something to do with the recent security updates of a couple weeks ago? I am not using any third-party downloading software.
