Hi all,

Two instances of a problem to share:

1) I have a web page that I go to from a link in my network, and if I have something open in another window, it always opens in that window instead of in a new one.

2) Another instance of this happening is when I'm listening to an online radio station. Often they have a little applet running in a window, and if you click on a web link somewhere, it opens it in the little applet window!

In both instances I have to open IE first to get a free window, then I open the application or applet second so it is not first in the task bar. IE picks the first window open in the task bar to use in both instances.

This is annoying and I was wondering if there was some way to "lock" a window from being used when open. I know I can open a link in a new window by holding the shift key, but that doesn't help me in instance one with my application link. Is there some command I could put in the icon that would force the application to open in a new window? Can I force IE to "always" open a new window?
