Looks like RegMon is less reliable than I thought then.

Yes I too think so, for another reason. When I try to capture "Write" accesses, RegMon sometimes logs all the "read" attempts, and sometimes it does not respect my Exclude filter (may be the filter string is very long.).

Set a filter for these two items, and you'll see RegMon displaying this (Imgutil.dll)

Looks like RegMon is less reliable than I thought then.
Those entries should have been picked up by my .dll filter too.

It looks as if there is a lot more caching going on than I realized too.

The best traces would probably be obtained by recreating the scenario with a new process. I think the process that I was commenting on yesterday was older than the one I was tracing today.

I didn't mention yesterday that some inexplicable entries for AR7.02's PDFShell.dll consistently show up. I think that may be indicative of how third-party programs could get into a chain of things and could be an example which validates my suggestion to try removing one, especially one which appears to have taken over a default local file type association.
