Hi Kelly :-)

Ok...then try the following information:

This is often caused by third-party browser add-ons or program running which are blocking pop-up windows, such as Yahoo Companion (should be uninstalled), Yahoo toolbar, Google toolbar, MSN toolbar, a firewall, or an IE shell program.

Yahoo installations have been known to cause this problem. See here:

If still no joy....try these steps:

Open IE,>Tools>Internet Options.
Select Advanced tab and click the [restore defaults] button.
Later, select the Programs and click the [reset web settings] button.
Click OK.
