Alan, I opened an Explorer Window (though I didn't understand your instructions on how to do it—I went Start>>My Computer>>Local Disk>>etc.) and went Tools>>Folder Options >> File Types. However, when I highlight the extension line for MP3 and WAV files, I get the message that I have customized them to open with a non-default program, along with a Restore button, as opposed to the Advanced button I bet with the other extension/file type items. I did do this—I want MP3 and WAV to open with Real. However, I want to be prompted first as though I were downloading a text document from the Web. You know, I should be able to go into Real and change this but I don't seem to be able to. Thanks a million. I was thinking about restoring defaults and then trying to do what you told me but I think I'll wait for your response.
