Hi,

I am trying to change my internet explorer security settings ("internet" zone) from 'high' to 'medium' so that a certain web page can display correctly. However, every time I try, it refuses to change, spouting an error dialog which reads:

The recommended security level for this zone is "High".  
The level that you have chosen is lower than this.  
Please choose a security level of "High" or higher.

Also, when I attempt to change the security level through the custom settings, by resetting all settings to "medium", the system hangs.

Does anyone know why IE isn't letting me change the settings, and how I might be able to persuade it to?
