This error message has been appearing on my screen when I close IE: "The instruction at 0x77279ab3 referenced memory at 0x7dc48950. The memory could not be read." It's been showing up at random times for a couple of months now.

Try making notes of what you are doing when it happens. There may be a common factor that you're not thinking of. E.g. one user discovered an apparent incompatibility between IE and an Office-installed module.

That case wouldn't be found using any of the diagnosis you have tried so far.

BTW as with the above case the crash address that you have could be suspicious and indicate the involvement of a third-party module. You could use the techniques I suggested to that poster but for a start just capture the Error Signature. That could tell us if there is a module name associated with that address range (e.g. 0x77270000, etc.)

I didn't download Hijack This like someone posted because I was afraid of accidently deleting something important off my computer.
