Hi Don.

Well, I did not try your complete solution, but while in safe mode with networking, I was able to get to the site. This leads me to believe there must be some kind of conflict with McAfee & Windows.

I'll have to try contacting McAfee's support desk. I'm wondering if this was one of the first sites I launched after a McAfee update. They recently released a new version of their Internet Security Suite and since this release, I've had a variety of problems (the red x issue that others have referred to on this board. McAfee was able to replicate my issue, but so far, I have not seen a fix).

I don't know why it's only one site.

Hi,

Go to Start> Run> msconfig> Startup tab, uncheck all McAfee items.

Go to Control panel> Windows firewall. Make sure that the Windows firewall is enabled.

Restart and try the troublesome site.

If no success with that, re-enable McAfee and contact the helpdesk of your ISP. See if they can reach <http://www.likesbooks.com/cgi-bin/rtr.pl> The problem might be at their level.

I noticed the problem about a week ago. I've contacted the website owner & there has been no change to the website. I can access all other pages on

the

[likesbooks.com](http://likesbooks.com) domain.

I'm running IE6 with XP SVS PK 1. I've got McAfee ISS 9 (which I had problems with, but was able to finally get fully installed and was able to access this page with the new update).

I've done a virus & spyware scan with no infected files found.
