Hi.

Lately I appear to be having a problem with internet explorer and I have no idea how to solve it.

I use IE 6 under win XP pro and recently had to re-install all my software because of a HD crash. Now IE is behaving rather odd. For instance, a website like www.m-w.com that I often use refuses to load. When I open the page, it loads fine, but when I enter a word to look it

up, it takes an extremely long time to load. It will first display the top part of the page in a few seconds, then it waits for a few minutes (normally webpages completely load in a few seconds) and then finally the complete webpage is displayed..

I'm quite sure the problem is not with www.m-w.com since I have the same problem on other websites. Strangely, I don't seem to be having this problem with all websites though (groups.google.com is working fine for instance).
