Now he's seeing them all over the place. I use my laptop instead of the family desktop so I've never noticed. Turns out we can't view videos or see certain images. They're marked only by the red X's. He also said that he first noticed it by not being able to see videos on You Tube, but he was able to get around that and see them through Google. But now he can't do that either. I've tried lowering our security settings, I've tried all but uninstalling and deleting Norton, and I've tried to open a photo or video saved on the computer, right-clicked, and set that file type to always open with either Windows Media Player or Windows Picture and Fax Viewer. I have checked the Microsoft site and our computer has every update (except for IE 7, which I can't do because I can't use Office WebMail for work if I do). To top it all off now You Tube is telling me that either Javascripts is turned off or our Macromedia Flash Player is outdated.
