Having obtained the official MS Update CD I proceeded to update both W2K (SP4) and IE (from 5.5 to 6 SP1). The W2K update appeared to work but I am now getting a message on boot up that requests original 2K cd to restore files, also the IE6 stops saying invalid signature and now I cannot get it to complete either from the CD or using download sites.
