> Something in your SP2 install didn't work then. Updating to SP2 should change the info in your mail headers to show version

> 6.00.2900.2527 to show that inetcomm.dll has been updated and your messages do not show that information in the headers. Either

> that, or you have installed an older version of inetcomm.dll for reasons that I don't understand.

> You can install SP2 safely with your antivirus program disabled and while working offline (not connected to the internet). You do

> not have to be connected to install it. And your firewall should not be disabled for any reason. Good luck.
