> *then 2 years later I wrote DBXpress, which explains the difference. They*

> *are also written in different languages, so merging them is not likely to*

> *Now, I would recommend using DBXpress as the front end extraction engine
and*

> *then using DBXtend for subsequent processing, which is what I often do.*

> *Both have command line options, which allows for automation via batch
