If OE downloads anything, even if it gets deleted automatically on download, it will show the new mail notification. There is no way to limit that notification to only good messages.

Perhaps this utility might be useful to you.

> seconds. I also tried splitting the rule so that it moved the spam
> 1st and

> then marked it read in the 2cnd rule. Lastly, I tried the 'stop
> processing

> more rules' but nothing is working.

> Ideally I would like NO notification if spam arrives and for it to be
> marked

> as read and moved to the spam folder I designated. Can anyone help?
