While viewing a message in the Preview Pane, click on the Information Bar just above the message to highlight it blue and then click Print.

This is the bar that contains To, From & Subject etc., but /not/ the Columns Bar above the message headers.

lately when I print some e-mails (not all) the header (ie. To, From, Sent, Subject) does not print out – how do I fix this?
