It would appear that you missed the folder you created on the Desktop and just dropped them all there.

Drag the OE window to the right to reveal most of the Desktop, keeping the folder tree visible. Hold the Ctrl key down while you click on each envelope to highlight them and then drag the group of envelopes back to a folder in the folder tree. (You may have to do this in a few steps).

The envelopes will still be on the Desktop, but you should have the messages back. Make sure, and if they are, you can delete the envelopes.

Now see if my second reply is a better solution.

To backup messages to a readable CD:

Create a folder on your Desktop, then in Outlook Express open the folder with the messages you want to save. Highlight one message, then Ctrl+A will highlight them all, (or hold the Ctrl button down while you select only the messages you want), Now, drag and drop them to the folder on your Desktop.
(Easiest if the folder shortcut is on the Taskbar).

Now you can copy that folder to a CD and you will be able to read the messages on the CD by double-clicking on them.

The downside of this is that messages that have the same subject will be overwritten. To avoid this, purchase:
