If you don't use OL for email, why do you use its Address Book?

Here's what I'd do:

1. Export your OL contacts as a CSV file.

2a. Disable sharing of (Windows/OE) Address Book contacts with OL – see <http://www.insideoe.com/files/wab.htm#share>.

2b. If you don't use any components of OL other than its contacts (e.g., Calendar), remove OL from your install of MS Office 2003 via Add/Remove
