Are you an MSN Premium or Hotmail Plus subscriber?

I've only seen that error once before and it involved and MSN Premium subscriber. It apparently & "automagically" cleared up on its own:

I am afraid the problem has not fixed itself overnight.

I am not a premium service subscriber.

The fact that others are experiencing it is interesting, and would help explain why OE access went away in Entourage on my macbook as well on Saturday. Interestingly it did not disappear on my wife's laptop, but she doesn't do automatic software updates (rarely updates at all!). So there is something awry at MSFT's end.

Anyway, I am still open for ideas, but I don't begin to know how to contact MSFT.
