

Changes to 'Scheduled Recs' on Extender not saved

Really frustrating this. I have 2 Extenders (Xbox and Linksys) and this occurs on both (but is fine from the MCE PC itself).

When I change the Scheduled Recordings in some way, e.g. set some programmes to Do Not Record or resolve other conflicts so the show I want records, it correctly shows what I want with the red circle and all seems well. However when it comes to recording time, it goes and records the other show instead! I miss the show I actually want. Grrr.

I tested this tonight and set it to resolve a conflict. The red circle changed correctly. 30 mins. later it recorded the other show instead. The APPLICATION event log at the time I made the change on the MCX is telling:

I first reported the events 3 months ago (<http://tinyurl.com/4yn6p>) and another user reported the same errors, but at that time neither of us realised the consequences. Can anyone help resolve this or advise if MS are aware?
