> I use Windows XP Home Edition, with Service Pack 2 installed. Recently, I  
> upgraded my motherboard, and the procedure I used to repair Windows was this:  
> boot from CD, and repair Windows from that. I repaired Windows with a Service  
> Pack 2 CD, and everything seems stable. However, I have a problem when trying  
> to switch to another user on the computer using Fast User Switching. Whenever  
> "Switch User" is used, it will display the Welcome Screen. One thing that is  
> wrong is that the user that has just been switched from will not have a "User  
> Is Logged On" message underneath the name. When you try clicking on a  
> different username, the screen will change to the default blue background for  
> a split second, but then change back to the Welcome Screen. Clicking on the  
> user that is currently logged on will return you to that user. During this  
> whole situation, there are no error screens or error sounds, etc. If anyone  
> has this problem and/or knows a solution to this, I would really like to know.
