>> You'd have to redo the install and catch the error. The utility just  
>> checks

>> HKEY\_LOCAL\_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\Microsoft\Windows\CurrentVersion\Media Center  
>> and allows you to change it if needed. If you have something other than a  
>> number there, then I couldn't tell you why.

>> I've never needed to do the domain hack, so I can't tell you what the  
>> consequences would be in this case.
