I would suspect that you're missing SP1 of the .NET Framework, or a security update for .Net SP1. I had some issues getting the 886903 patch to install on a couple of machines.

> Particularly the first one, as it should contain the immediate information  
> about the install. The MedCtrOC.log will have changes, as well, towards the  
> end of the file.

>>> and allows you to change it if needed. If you have something other than  
>>> a  
>>> number there, then I couldn't tell you why.
