You should use the stock Linksys firmware; however, if you absolutely have to have the functionality found in 3rd party firmware revs, you should try the tofu firmware... I've been using this with no problems on the Xbox and Media Center Extenders.

You can get the tofu firmware revs from <http://polarcloud.com/tofu>

For the sake of troubleshooting, get it working on the stock firmware first, then get the 3rd party firmware afterwards.

All right, I replaced the router and I the Extender Manager software \*always\* finds the 360. Only the "Session Terminated" error occurs now. There are no errors corresponding to the time of the error the 360 displayed.
