You probably installed the .net framework or something else that installed an additional user.

This disables the auto login feature when your password is blank (which really isn't very secure to start off with anyways).

To easily restore auto-login, follow these instructions.

Goto Start, Run and type "control userpasswords2"
Then under the users tab, uncheck Users must enter a username/pass to use this computer"
Then press ok and Enter your username/password
