Once I rebooted after the new driver settings I have more options on the advanced tab. I have changed the duplex settings from auto to 100mbps full duplex. I'm using an intel pro 100 ve. But it's still the same. Also when I try to run the MCE Network Performance Tuner I get an error "application has generated an exception that could not be handled" The application is the MCXNeTW.exe Common Language Runtime Debugging Services. Could this be a part of the problem ?

– Change your Ethernet card to 100 mbps full duplex if it's set to Auto

Detect or vice versa:

.. 1) Right click My Computer, select Manage, click Device Manager

.. 2) Expand Network adapters; double-click your network card

.. 3) Select the Advanced tab

.. 4) Select Link Speed & Duplex; what is the Value? Try changing
