Everything has been working fine without any problems for the last few months. Last night I bought a 360 and set up up to be a MCE Extender.

The

install went fine, the media-center app comes up on the 360 just fine. I

can

browse my recorded video and see everything correctly.

If I try to play something, the 360 manages to play about a second of it

and

then the Media Center hangs solid and completely. No keyboard, Task

Manager

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freezes, etc. Only recourse is to use the reset button.

I've tried downloading new video drivers, completely removed all antivirus and firewalls, etc. I tried reinstalling and there were no errors in the setup. It happens even if there is noone logged in to the media center.

The only thing I can think of is that it has something to do with the dual-core issue, but I don't have access to the HotFix here.
