.NET is a progression, and it was decided to keep them separate. Programs that need .NET 1.0 or 1.1 will call those libraries. Later programs that use .NET 2.0 will use those libraries. You should be able to install ..NET 2.0 with 1.1 installed. I've done it on multiple machines with zero issues.
