There is a substantial amount of lag when using the Xbox360 as an Extender with Vista RC1 x64 build 5600. This delay is sometimes 30 seconds or so between key strokes. They are connected via gigabit LAN. I noticed the `wmplayer.exe` process running in 32-bit mode with virtualization.

The hardware has a dual boot with MCE 2005 and Vista RC1 x64 Build 5600.

There is a large dedicated volume (RAID array) for media. Both OS partitions draw media from this volume.

The MCE 2005 version works flawlessly.
