I'm having a problem viewing my local HD channels in Media Center. They load fine in setup (signals are also good), but when I try to change to them in the guide, up pops a black screen and then this error: Application Failure. A Critical Media Center process has failed. Please restart your computer and try again. If the problem persists contact your hardware manufacturer for further assistance.

I have contacted them and have not received much help at all. They tell me it has to be a Media Center problem. Nice. I'm running a TV Wonder 650 Combo with the latest drivers and Windows XP Media Center Edition 2005 with Service Pack 3 and .NET Framework 2.0. Although my system properties say it's Media Center Edition 2002 which I don't understand either...lol. Any help with this problem (and why my OS is identified incorrectly as well) would be MUCH appreciated. Thanks...
