What tuner or video capture device are you using in MCE?
You can use Y-cables to connect both the TV and the computer to the CoolSat box at the same time.

Then what you get on the TV is also on the tuner or capture card. Audio configure is to use the Audio input from the device you are using.

Make sure your sound is not muted on the computer and the volume controls are turned up.

Bitstream audio from SPDIF is PCM audio, and must have a decoder. MCE does
