Hi Al,

Thanks for the answer. I got some strange behaviour:

– on the certificate services server (which is one of my DC's) I do not see much errors at all, besides the one I have shown and one more event

KDC warning event id 20:

The currently selected KDC certificate was once valid, but now is invalid and no suitable replacement was found. Smartcard logon may not function correctly if this problem is not remedied. – I tried to publish the certificates manually to my server store, but this did not help.

– netdiag and dcdiag seem OK
