

Protected Groups changing rights

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We have a problem here where someone had added all users to one of the AD protected groups. This modified the rights on the user objects (specifically the rights "Self" had to the user object) we have removed all users from the protected group but now the rights that "self" has is incorrect on the user accounts. This has caused an issue where users can not add delegates to their exchange mailbox. They add the delegate in their outlook client but it does not get written to exchange. If I modify the rights that "self" has back to what they should be then this works fine.

So my question is this. Does anyone know if there is a way to reset users rights back to what they were before (defaults) the user was moved into the protected group? Or can anyone suggest a way to mass edit the user objects to add these rights back in?

If not does anybody know if you can create a script to check each user object and report if the "Self" rights are correct?
