- > automatically. We do not know what is doing this. I thought that maybe
- > one
- > of our DCs did not have the right setting and replicating this change.
- > But
- > I checked the domain policy on all of the DC and they are all set to 230.
- > Has anyone seen something like this? Any ideas appreciated.
