Here are the scenario:

I have 2 domains in different forests – domainA (Windows 2003 native) and domainB (Windows 2000 native). I have made an external one-way trust (not transitive) from domainA to domainB.

I am trying to achieve, that users in domainB can access SQL analysys services in domainA. If I understood correctly, I can add users from the domainB only to the local domain group in domainA.

But if I am trying to search for this domain local group from SQL server (in domainA), I can not found it – only global groups are listed. What I am doing wrong?

And is it possible to add global group to the domain local group?
