Sorry for the delay – I wanted to verify this in one of my customer environments – they have several domains in a forest. I haven't been able to yet, as I've been out of the office.

Try adding the necessary NTDS Settings object DN into the serverReference attribute, regardless of domain. This is like so:

CN=NTDS Settings, CN=<Computer name>, CN=Servers, CN=<Site name>, CN=Sites, CN=Configuration, DC=<forest root>,DC=com

e.g.

CN=NTDS Settings, CN=LON-MIIS, CN=Servers, CN=Default-First-Site-Name, CN=Sites, CN=Configuration, DC=fabrikam,DC=com

Note. There appears to be a typo in the DN listed in the KB. The above is correct – pasted from a VM.
