This also means that if he tries to install a printer that he will be unable to find one to install. Does anyone have any ideas about how to trouble shoot this further. I am lost.

Sound less like a user permission issue and more like a netbios issue. The browse list (My Network Places) is populated using browser elections and netbios broadcasts. Not very reliable these days.

Have you tried having him add the printer by machine name explicitly? i.e. printer HP is connected to machine HOST1. If you go into the add printer wizard, you can choose to specify the printer and type in \\host1\hp and see if he connects.

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
