The system is running windows 2003 standard edition with SP1. This is a domain controller.

I logged with a user account member of both Enterprise Admin & Domain-Admin builtin groups.

<quote>FYI: The build in group ENTERPRISE DOMAIN CONTROLLERS should have read and autoenroll, enroll rights, that group covers all domain controllers within the forest</quote>

Well but when i try to give read access to the Enterprise Domain Controllers i receive a message error :

Unable to save permission changes to LDAP:
DomainName\DomainControllerAuthentication,CN=CertificateTemplate,CN=PublicKeyServices,CN=Services,CN=C
A referral was returned from the server

So i am blocked at that point and i dont see what i can do as ther's not even an article about that in the KB, i have tried to install and reinstall the CA but no luck.
