What version of your Novell Server?

If the server is 5.0 or above, you can synchronize it using AD protocol for Netware. Install Novell Client in the AD server and make it to sync.

Hi,

we have to setup 2 servers on a client network.
generally we are connected to an AD.
But a client has not a centralized AD and security system.

So each unit has is own Novell server! (for a total of 73)

So, we want to synchronize our AD with these servers. 1 way sync. is enough.
We have to lookat a solution which has a minimal impact and cost from a software point of view.

Our application works fine in single sign-on mode (which is generally the usage on a local network), but in remote access without single sign-on capability its more difficult for an end user.

We have to provide solutions as quickly as possible.
