The users were set up about 12 months ago with no password expiration and the passwords have never changed since they were created,

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furthermore if the server is rebooted then they start up  
and  
continue to work for a few days with no problems. In fact I  
only see the  
error as the database package is closed down each night to  
allow the  
backup and then the restart fails.

I have a machine that used  
to hold all 5 FMSO roles  
and was both a DNS  
server and DHCP server,  
along with an email package  
and database  
package. The latter 2 ran as  
a service with dedicated  
username  
specifically set up to run the  
service.

After running for a few days  
these packages refused to  
start up using  
the username credentials  
that had worked previously.
