I have a local user account that is a member of the local admins group on over 100 hundred servers. I would like to disable this local account from a central location (my pc) instead of logging into each server and manually disabling. I am a domain admin.

I would also prefer not to do this by using computer management and connecting to the servers I want to disable the account on.

If I cannot do this i'd like to at least be able to change the password of this local user account from my pc instead of logging into each server. Can this be done with a script or batch file. If so can anyone provide some sample code as I am not very familiar with writing scripts?
