I'm having trouble trying to create a test roaming profile on a win2003 server..

I did the following procedures:  
setup test user in AD  
went to a laptop and logged in as test user  
logged off laptop  
\*\*now here is where the trouble begins \*\*  
I log back on the laptop with admin rights  
I select advanced in system properties  
I click on user files  
The list shows the "test user"  
However, it will not give me an option to "copy to" , which copies the local profile to the server on a designated share.

What am I doing wrong?

I need to get this to work before I can deploy roaming to other users  
by specifying \\server\profile\%username% in user profiles.
